MINUTES OF THE 28th ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

Date and Time : 22nd Dec 2021 (Wednesday) at 4.00 p.m.

Place : Virtual (Zoom Meeting Platform)

Attendance

The AGM was attended by 49 voting members (Appendix 1). The President, Emeritus Prof. Dr. Mohd Ismail Noor, called the meeting to order at 4.05 pm after the quorum was achieved.

Agenda 1: Welcome Address by the President

On behalf of MASO 15th Council, Emeritus Prof. Dr. Mohd Ismail Noor thanked members for their presence and support to enable us to achieve the quorum and welcomed them to the 28th AGM. The President updated that the Council activities since the last AGM and highlighted that most of the activities involved with organizing and successfully hosting the Asia-Oceania Conference on Obesity AOCO - MASO 2021 held on 6-8 April 2021. The Council also worked hard in obtaining approval from the ROS on the amendments to the MASO Rules and Regulations. Due to some technical difficulties on eROSES system, an Extraordinary General Meeting (EGM) was held on 12th August 2021 to reapprove the proposal adopted at the 27th AGM held on 10th December 2020. The President also announced that after serving as the President since 1996 and with the amended Rules and Regulation in place, he and several senior council members who have served MASO for several years (Prof. Dr. Norimah A. Karim, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Mahenderan Appukutty, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Chin Yit Siew, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Gan Wan Ying and Puan Zaiton Daud) has agreed not to contest in this year election to pave way for younger and vibrant members to serve in the Council and bring MASO forward to a greater height. He thanked all Council members that had worked together with him in the past 25 during which MASO have successfully organised and hosted AOCO 2003, APOC 2007, ICO 2014 and AOCO-MASO 2021, besides the MASO Biennial Conference since 1995. These are indeed great achievements and has put MASO on a firm footing as a recognized Professional body nationally and internationally. He shared a short video of AOCO-MASO 2021 to refresh the memories of the members who attended and contributed to the conference. He also encouraged members to be more active and continue to support the new Council for MASO upcoming activities.

Agenda 4: Adoption of the MASO Council Report for 2020 – 2021

The Honorary Secretary, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Geeta Appannah presented the Council Report for 2020 – 2021. Various MASO activities conducted in 2020 and 2021 were presented to the members. A total of 5 council meetings were held over the past year excluding the numerous meetings the Council attended which focused on organising the AOCO-MASO 2021.

4.1 MASO Membership

As of the end of November 2021, MASO have 289 registered members. The categories of membership status are as follows: Life 101, Ordinary 187, Associate 0, and Corporate 1. The only Associate member we had terminated her membership when she migrated overseas.

4.2 MASO Website

- i) Dr. Denise Koh Choon Lian and Assoc. Prof. Dr. Mohd Razif Shahril are responsible for the MASO website, and they had worked with the webmaster, Mr. Lim Kooi Fong to update the MASO website. The website has been updated with information and photographs of MASO activities, including Asia-Oceania Conference on Obesity & MASO Scientific Conference on Obesity 2021 (AOCO-MASO 2021) and Nutrition Month Malaysia 2021. Besides that, the announcement of seminars and conferences related to obesity were also included on the website.
- ii) Members are encouraged to log in to MASO website for recent updates on MASO activities and events. The URL is www.maso.org.my. Members are also encouraged to provide information related to obesity to be disseminated to other members and the public at large.
- iii) MASO wish to express our thanks to Mr Lim Kooi Fong (webmaster) for his continued services to the Association.

4.3 MASO Activities

Despite being a challenging year due to the Covid 19 pandemic, MASO has continued its collaborations with the Ministry of Health (MOH), the Nutrition Society of Malaysia (NSM) and the Malaysian Dietitians' Association (MDA). The key activities among others were:

- Successfully organized and hosted the Asia-Oceania Conference on Obesity & MASO Scientific Conference on Obesity (AOCO-MASO) 2021 virtually with the theme of "Tackling Obesity: Innovative Strategies for a Healthier Future" on 6th to 8th April 2021 in conjunction with World Obesity Day.
- Revision of Strategies to Prevent Obesity in Malaysia (SPOM) 2005.
- Nutrition Month Malaysia 2021 in collaboration with NSM and MDA
- Continued to be involved in numerous Technical Committees of the MOH, Malaysia.

i) Asia-Oceania Conference on Obesity & MASO Scientific Conference on Obesity (AOCO-MASO) 2021

- a) AOCO-MASO 2021 has been successfully organized by MASO under the auspices of AOASO and in conjunction with the World Obesity Day. The theme of AOCO-MASO 2021 “Tackling Obesity: Innovative Strategies for a Healthier Future” provided a platform for participants to discuss the challenges and opportunities in preventing and managing the rising obesity epidemic in the region.
- b) The three-day virtual scientific conference held from 6th to 8th April 2021 was officiated by Tan Sri Dato’ Seri Dr. Noor Hisham Abdullah, Director General of Health Malaysia and hosted more than 500 local and international participants.
- c) The Scientific Committee delivered a comprehensive programme covering different aspects of obesity which included five plenary lectures, 12 Symposia sessions (with 48 invited speakers), four Free communication sessions, the AOCO Rising Star symposium and AOASO President’s Country updates as well as 100 poster presentations.

ii) Revision of Strategies of Obesity Prevention in Malaysia (SPOM)

- a) Emeritus Prof. Dr. Mohd Ismail Noor is the Chairperson for this revision while Assoc. Prof. Dr. Geeta Appannah and Assoc. Prof. Dr. Mohd Razif Shahril are the Secretary and Assistant Secretary. Besides other members, all council members agreed to be involved either as lead writers and writers of the proposed six (6) chapters in this revision.
- b) This revision will be also comprised of psychology (behavioral modifications), health economics, genetic and social sciences aspects, on top of the usual dietary, physical activity and policy components. Twenty-five writers from various universities as well as MOH were identified and approached for their contributions to this revision.
- c) The first draft of the revised SPOM report is now compiled. The committee together with the writers will be meeting sometime in January or February 2022 to finalize the draft. It is expected that the revised report to be ready by mid of 2022.
- d) The MASO council agreed that the fund’s balance from the Suku Suku Separuh and Cergas (3SC) activity will be used to finance the update of SPOM 2005.

iii) MASO Scientific Update

- a) In conjunction with 27th MASO AGM, MASO held a Scientific Update and invited Asst. Prof. Dr. Jamilah Hanum Abdul Khaiyom, International Islamic University Malaysia (IIUM). She presented a talk on “The Use of Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT) for Weight Loss and Maintenance” on 10th December 2020 (Thursday) at 4.00 pm virtually using Zoom Platform.
- b) For the year 2021, MASO Scientific Update was presented subsequently after the 28th AGM on 22nd December 2021 virtually through Zoom Meeting platform by Prof Dr Peymane Adab from the University of Birmingham, UK. She presented her talk on “Promoting Healthy Weight in Children: Lessons from Research Over the Last Decade” and the session was moderated by Assoc. Prof. Dr. Geeta Appannah.

iv) MASO World Obesity Day Celebration

- a) World Obesity Day is now observed on the 4th March of each year (previously it was on the 11th October). However, all activities related to World Obesity Day (WOD) 2021 were put on hold for this year due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- b) MASO however designated AOCO-MASO 2021 Conference held Virtually from 5 to 7 April 2021 and promoted WOD during the event.

v) MASO Camp

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, all activities related to MASO Camp were put on hold.

v) MASO Education Fund

There was no application for MASO Education Fund in 2021.

4.4 MASO Affiliation with other Professional Bodies and Activities Involved

i) World Obesity Federation (WO)

- a) MASO has been affiliated with the World Obesity Federation (WO), previously known as the International Association for the Study of Obesity (IASO) since 1998. Various webinars were conducted throughout the year specifically related to Obesity and COVID-19.

This, according to her will include more training for professionals, driving national efforts through involvement in policy development, planning effective and interesting activities, moving out of our comfort zones and venturing into new possibilities.
- v. The President conveyed her thanks to all members present for their continued support throughout the years and is hopeful for greater support in the coming session.
